Organizational Structure: The Florida Exotic Pest Plant Council has a 13 member board of directors with five officers. There are 18 committees and nine task forces which each focus on specific types of invasives.

Synopsis: The mission of the Florida Exotic Pest Plant Council is to support the management of invasive exotic plants in Florida's natural areas by providing a forum for the exchange of scientific, educational, and technical information. FLEPPC goals are to build public awareness about the serious threat invasive plants pose to native ecosystems, to help secure funding and support for control and management of exotic pest plants, and to develop integrated management and control methods to prevent the spread of exotic pest plants throughout Florida.
