501 (C) (3) Application Approval: Should be back in the 501c3 status by the end of February 2008 if not sooner.

Membership: 23 members, no fee as of yet

Number of Meetings Per Year: First meeting to revive the PNW EPPC was in September of 2006. There have been no meetings since then.

Budget: The Forest Service has provided some funding for getting the group going again. \$15,000 was provided from the National Parks Service.

States Represented: Oregon, Washington, British Columbia, Yukon and Alaska.

Organizational Structure: There is a temporary twenty two member board of directors.

Synopsis: PNW IPC was active from December 1993 until 1997. The group was revised in 2006 at a conference but did not have anyone working on it until mid 2007. There is currently a temporary board of directors representing a wide range of interested individuals, and a paid coordinator working on the web site, a brochure, and proposals for additional funding. Future projects will include starting a public education campaign, moving the WSNLA/WALP task force under the PNW EPPC, and beginning an EDRR program.
